Drugs, guns and cash seized in Friday bust

Methamphetamine, prescription pills, drug paraphernalia, 70 firearms and a pile of cash were recovered Friday after officers raided a Bucyrus home.

The items were collected after the Crawford County Special Response Team executed a narcotic search warrant 130 Dudley St., according to a news release from the Crawford County Sheriff's Office, which is handling the investigation.

Arrested at the residence was Charles Irwin Jr., 52, and Brooke Morgan, 31.



Irwin was taken to the Crawford County Justice Center and charged with third-degree felony trafficking in drugs. The news release indicated more charges were pending against him.



Morgan was held in jail on fifth-degree felony count of possession of drugs.

This investigation was a joint effort among the sheriffs' offices of Crawford and Wyandot counties, the Bucyrus Police Department and the METRICH drug task force.

The case is still ongoing and will be submitted to the Crawford County Prosecutor's Office for review, according to the news release.

Crawford County Sheriff Scott Kent encourages anyone with knowledge of other drug activity to contact their local law enforcement.
