Vehicle search in Tiffin yields drugs and two arrests

On Monday the Seneca County Drug Task Force METRICH Enforcement Unit, along with additional agents and officers from Seneca County DIPO Probation, Ohio Attorney General's Office Bureau of Criminal Investigation, Seneca County Sheriff's Department and Tiffin Police Department executed a search warrant on a vehicle during a traffic stop on Maule Road in Seneca County.

The search unveiled suspected crack cocaine, suspected heroine, suspected marijuana, US currency, drug paraphernalia and criminal tools, a release from the METRICH unit states.

Kimberly A. Kistler, 48, of Tiffin was arrested for a probation violation with additional pending charges for drug trafficking, complicity of trafficking in drugs and possession of drug paraphernalia, according to the release. The additional charges are pending at the conclusion of the entire investigation, the release states.

Devon T. Brockington, 36, of Tiffin was arrested for possession of criminal tools with additional pending charges of drug trafficking and illegal conveyance of drugs into a detention facility, the release states. The additional charges are also pending on Brockington at the conclusion of the entire investigation, it states.

They are both currently being held at the Seneca County Correctional Facility pending further court proceedings.

"Today's operation is yet another example of the mutual aid this county is known for," said Sheriff Fred Stevens. "The collaborative efforts of the Drug Task Force, Tiffin Police Department and Seneca County Sheriff's office were on full display today.
