One arrested in Findlay drug raid

One person was arrested early Thursday morning after a search of a Findlay residence yielded a large amount of fentanyl powder.

According to a news release from the Hancock County METRICH Drug Task Force, the force, along with the Findlay Police Department Emergency Response Team, executed a search warrant at 916½ W. Main Cross St. at approximately 6:32 a.m.

The search yielded a large amount of fentanyl powder. Officers also seized cash, other drug paraphernalia and items indicative of drug trafficking, the release states.

Brittany A. Ferguson, 30, was arrested and incarcerated at the Hancock County Justice Center on a charge of possession of fentanyl, a third-degree felony. Additional charges related to drug trafficking are expected at the conclusion of the investigation, according to the release.
