

Two jailed after search warrant is executed in Findlay

Two people were arrested and incarcerated after a search warrant was executed Wednesday in Findlay.

According to a press release from the Hancock County METRICH Drug Task Force, the search warrant was executed at approximately 3:36 p.m. at 410 Washington St.

The task force says the search of the residence yielded suspected raw marijuana, THC edibles and numerous pieces of drug paraphernalia.

Arrested and incarcerated at the Hancock County Justice Center were:

- Raheem X.T. Glenn, 26, of 410 Washington St., charged with possession of marijuana, a fifth-degree felony.
- Kyren J. Faciane, 27, of Detroit, charged with obstructing official business, a second-degree misdemeanor. He is also being held on a weapons violation warrant out of Michigan, with a \$20,000 bond.

The task force says additional charges of drug trafficking are expected at the conclusion of the investigation.

Assisting was the Findlay Police Department Emergency Response Team (ERT).
