Search warrant yields large amount of meth

A search warrant executed by law enforcement at a Western Avenue residence late Monday yielded a large amount of methamphetamine.

According to a release from the Hancock METRICH Drug Enforcement Unit, the Hancock County METRICH Drug Task Force and the Findlay Police Department Emergency Response Team executed a search warrant at 10:50 p.m. Monday at 206 Western Ave. The search yielded 111 grams of methamphetamine, numerous loose prescription pills and drug paraphernalia.

The evidence substantiated an ongoing investigation into the residence for suspected drug possession and drug trafficking, according to the release.

Substances seized will be sent for further testing, according to the release. Charges for drug trafficking, drug possession and paraphernalia possession will be sought at a later date, pending lab results.

The release identified one suspect: Derek A. Boyd, 26, of 206 Defiance Ave.

The incident remains under investigation.
