Woman arrested on drug charged in Findlay

A woman in Findlay was arrested after a search warrant was served at a residence in that city late Wednesday morning.

The search of the residence yielded suspected methamphetamine and several items of drug paraphernalia.

Other items indicative of drug trafficking and cash were also seized.

As a result, 40 year old Jessica M. Shepherd was arrested and incarcerated at the Hancock County Justice Center on a charge of possession of methamphetamine.

Additional charges of drug trafficking are expected at the conclusion of this investigation.

On 11/29/2023 at approx. 1102 hrs. the Hancock County METRICH Drug Task Force along with Officers and Detectives from the Findlay Police Department, executed a narcotic search warrant at 231 E. Foulke Ave., Apt. 3, Findlay, Ohio.
