

Man arrested following drug operation in Fostoria

A Tiffin man was arrested following a drug operation in Fostoria last week.

On Nov. 14, the Seneca County Drug Task Force-METRICH Enforcement Unit and Fostoria Police officers conducted a drug operation near East Fremont Street and Anderson Avenue in Fostoria.



According to the Seneca County Sheriff's Office, during the operation, officers seized suspected heroin, methamphetamine, cocaine a stolen firearm and money.

Following the operation, officers arrested Cody Johnson, 34, of Tiffin for an active warrant for Failure to Appear in Seneca County. Charges of Possession of Methamphetamine, Possession of Heroin, Possession of Cocaine and Possession of a Stolen Firearm are pending following an investigation.

Johnson is being held at the Seneca County Jail.

“This investigation is consistent with what local Law Enforcement is seeing with an influx of Methamphetamine, Heroin, and Cocaine trafficking and abuse in our area. We are utilizing all of our resources to attempt to track down the source of the illicit drugs to prevent any further overdoses and to prosecute those who continue to bring them into our community,” said Fostoria Police Chief Gabriel Wedge. “I’m always pleased to see another firearm removed from a dangerous criminal’s hands.”
