

Findlay vape shop raided by drug task force

At approximately 3 p.m. Tuesday, the Hancock County METRICH Drug Task Force and the Findlay Police Department executed a search warrant at Major Vapor, located at 1749 Tiffin Ave. in Findlay.

A release from METRICH states local law enforcement had received "multiple complaints regarding suspected illegal activity" at the shop, including the illegal sale of marijuana to both adults and juveniles, and METRICH opened an investigation.

Task force members completed controlled purchases of suspected illegal products from the business and confirmed a purchase involving a juvenile, the release states.

"The search yielded marijuana, marijuana vapes, THC edibles, psilocybin edibles, a handgun and a large sum of cash," the release states.

Charges of drug trafficking and possession of drugs are expected after the completion of the investigation, it states.
