

Findlay bust yields suspected meth

The Findlay Police Emergency Response Team and Hancock County METRICH Drug Task Force executed a bust that ended with the arrest of two and yielded suspected methamphetamine overnight Thursday.

At approximately 1 a.m., Hancock County METRICH and FPD ERT executed a narcotic search warrant at 2034 Elyria St., Findlay, a release states.

“The search of the residence yielded 11 ounces of suspected methamphetamine and multiple items indicative of drug trafficking,” it states.

As a result of the search, Tre Gerlach, 26, of Findlay, and Danielle Rall, 51, of Findlay, were taken into custody.

Gerlach will be charged with complicity of a felony and Rall will be charged with possession of drugs. Additional charges of drug trafficking and possession of drugs are expected at the conclusion of the investigation, the release states.
