

Findlay woman arrested in prostitution sting

A prostitution sting in Bluffton Monday ended in the arrest of one and the confiscation of a variety of drugs.

Lydia Myer, 33, of Findlay, was taken into custody as a result of the sting.

According to a release, the Hancock County METRICH task force executed the sting at the Fairway Inn in Bluffton at approximately 3:30 p.m. Monday, which yielded “a large amount of suspected liquid methamphetamine, 88 tablets of LSD, 6 Schedule II pills, 1 gun and drug paraphernalia,” the release reads.

Myers is being held at the Hancock County Justice Center on charges of engaging in prostitution, obstructing official business, possession of drug abuse instruments, possession of LSD and possession of Schedule II narcotics.

Additional charges of illegal manufacturing of drugs and possession of drugs are expected pending further investigation.
