

## Crawford County deputies seize 56 grams of meth in traffic stop, 2 arrested

A narcotics investigation in Crawford County ended with two men jailed after deputies said they found methamphetamine during a traffic stop Monday.

The Crawford County Sheriff's Office conducted a traffic stop on a 2014 Dodge Grand Caravan on State Route 100 near Monnett New Winchester Road. The driver was identified as Nathan Brady, 46, who deputies said was the target of the investigation. The passenger was identified as Waylon James, 35.



Deputies discovered about 56 grams of methamphetamine, drug paraphernalia and cash during the stop.

Brady and James were transported to the Crawford County Justice Center and are being held on charges of possession of drugs, a second-degree felony. The sheriff's office said reports will be forwarded to the Crawford County Prosecutor's Office for consideration of additional charges.
